Field Manager

Sam Crum came to introduce his recommended well driller, since Sam does not drill anymore. His name is Raymon Ward with Eagle Drilling. I had them go up to the Pinecrest tanks since they are at the top of our system, where we order the most of our water. Sam used dosing rods to find the best location to drill. Raymond sent us a bid for that well. Our current problem is that we do not have any power at that site. We need to investigate what it would cost to have Edison provide power there.

Weed abatement is close to completion with only the easements to finish.

System dead end flushing started late this year, we expect to be finished this week.

USA's this month have taken up considerable district time. The Gas company is replacing main, so we are having to mark all our infrastructure on entire streets.
