Field Maintenance

District flushing, meter testing and inventory have all been completed. eAR has been corrected, sent in and approved.

Valley View Park has reached back out to us and wants us to do the tank readings and CLAWA adjustments again. They retired Jim. We agreed to help them out. Currently we are about 80% completed with their AMI system meter change out, on track before their next meter reading time. We hung notices to half the system that will be out of water during repairs on 5/14 and 5/15. This will allow Cla-Val to repair their valves and have the system work properly again.

Right now, at Brookside tank we only fill it with CLAWA water in that zone. This costs the district a little more than \$25,000 a year. We were exploring the idea of putting a Cla-Val in a vault below the wells on Brookside Rd. It could reduce the dangerous pressure and auto fill the tank as needed. This would be using Old Mill/Saxon water instead. We believe this would help us use up more water that we currently have available but are not using in that zone.

Valley View Meeting:

CPF Request: All the details regarding the upgrades that the District is looking to do with our meters have been sent to Congressman Obernolte's office. Following two conversations with Patrick Paolini, the Legislative Director for the Congressman, We have been told that our project will be submitted for approval. The District was the only project of the 26 submitted from our area. Most projects ask for 3 to 4 times more than our this project which along with being the only one from our area provides, according to Mr. Paolini, the District with a high probability of being approved for the entire amount.

SCE Meeting: Had a Zoom meeting with Edison on power shut-offs and what triggers them. Discussion centered around how to anticipate when shut-offs would be necessary and preparedness for when shut-offs occur.

CLAWA Rate Increase: CLAWA will have a public hearing on June 17, at 2 p.m. Our Board Meeting is at 3 p.m. that same day. It might be beneficial to move the Board meeting to the 18th if the Board feels it necessary to attend his meeting.
